INFRACTIONS

All seventh and eighth grade students who participate in activities are subject to disciplinary action as described below for any of the following behaviors based on the policies of Laramie County School District Number One.

1. Use of or possession of tobacco, alcohol, marijuana, or any other illegal, controlled substance, as defined by Wyoming State Law and Laramie County School District Number One Board policy while on or off school grounds.
2. Theft or vandalism of property.
3. Repeated acts of unsportsmanlike conduct (i.e., fighting, verbal abuse).
4. While on school grounds or involved in any school-sponsored activity, a participant will not wear apparel that pertains to alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or conveys inappropriate, vulgar or profane messages.
5. Any behavior that is clearly detrimental to the welfare, safety, or morals of other students.

ANY VIOLATION OF THIS CODE BY THE PARTICIPANT MAY RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING ACTION:

- Suspension from all contests for a period of time determined by an administrator while the activity is in session. If the participant is not currently participating in an activity, the penalty will begin at the opening contest of his or her next activity season. Reinstatement will be after the suspension and a parental conference with an administrator and/or the activities director. Participants **MUST** participate in all practices during the suspension. The participant will continue to remain under the activities code while under suspension.
- If drugs or alcohol are involved, the participant and parents must meet with an administrator and/or the activities director, and the student assistance specialist. The participant must enroll in the school Student Assistance Program (SAP) or an optional private program. The participant may not practice until his or her activities sponsor has received notification from the activities director that preliminary contact has occurred.
- Based upon the severity and the number of offenses, an administrator and activities sponsor can determine that the appropriate consequences may go beyond a mandatory suspension and may result in a suspension from all activity practices and contests for the remainder of that activity's season and possibly the entire school year.

ANY APPEALS TO THIS CODE MUST BE PRESENTED IN WRITING TO THE PRINCIPAL WITHIN SEVEN (7) CALENDAR DAYS OF THE RECEIPT OF THE DECISION.

THESE CONSEQUENCES APPLY TO ALL PARTICIPANTS WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THEIR ACTIVITY(IES) AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION.
